

## Construction Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Overton, Texas will receive bids for 2018 Street Improvements, TxCDBG #7217341 until **2:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, August 14, 2018**. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that stated time and date at City Hall located at 1200 S. Commerce, Overton, TX 75684.

The project will consist of constructing approximately 9,957 SY of pulvermix and asphalt overlay and miscellaneous water improvements.

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file at Hayes Engineering, Inc., 2126 Alpine St., Longview, TX 75601, (903) 758-2010. Copies of the Bid/Contract Documents/Plans may be obtained for \$30 (no refunds) from the Engineer.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Overton, Texas or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. Adherence to the grant recipient's Section 3 Policy is required for contracts and subcontracts in excess of \$100,000.00.

The City of Overton reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by the City of Overton for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
